Questions

Why were Joseph's brothers angry with him?

What happened in Joseph's dreams?

How did his brothers and father respond when Joseph told them about his dreams?

When Joseph was sent to find his brothers, how did his brothers respond when they saw Joseph?

In the end, what did the brothers do and why?

Was Reuben different from the other brothers? How?

How did the brothers explain Joseph's disappearance to Jacob, their father?

Joseph's brothers were angry with and envious of Joseph. Those feelings led them to hurt Joseph. Then they lied about it to their father. One sin led to another sin, and another. What can we learn from this?

Prayer Prompts

Pray that these verses would affect our heart and mind.

Thank God that even though we are sinful, he loves us anyway.

Pray that God would help us love people today, no matter the circumstance.

TUESDAY DEVOTIONAL

Read

Genesis 39:1 - 40:40

Questions

What happened to Joseph after he was sold into slavery?

Why was Joseph successful?

What happened that got Joseph in trouble?

How did God use Joseph while he was in prison to show God's power?

How long did Joseph have to wait in prison before the cup bearer remembered him?

What did Pharaoh's dreams mean?

What did Joseph recommend to Pharaoh in light of the meaning of the dreams?

How did Pharaoh respond to Joseph's recommendation?

How do you think Joseph felt?

Joseph had to wait for the Lord a long time. That was very hard.

How can Joseph's story encourage us?

Prayer Prompts

Pray that these verses would affect our hearts and minds.

Praise God for his faithfulness even in circumstances when we don't think he is with us.

Pray that we would be able to trust in him.

Pray that God would give us patience today.



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WEDNESDAY DEVOTIONAL

Read

Genesis 41:41 - 43:34

Questions

How did Pharaoh bless Joseph?

Read verses 41:50-52. What was going on in Joseph's heart?

What did Jacob (Joseph's father) and his sons (Joseph's brothers) do when they ran out of food because of the famine?

What happened when they met Joseph? How did Joseph treat them?

In chapter 42, the brothers feel like their bad luck is because of how they treated Joseph when they were younger. How does Joseph respond when he hears their remorse? What does he do for them?

When the brothers get home, what do they tell their father, Jacob?
How did Jacob respond?

When Jacob and the brothers run out of food again, what do they do?

When the brothers arrive in Egypt, what happens?

Do you think Joseph wants to forgive his brothers?

Prayer Prompts

Pray that these verses would affect our hearts and minds.

Praise God that he changes hearts and that he provides for us.

Pray that he would help us forgive others today.



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THURSDAY DEVOTIONAL

Read

Genesis 44 - 45

Questions

What does Joseph do to test his brothers? What happens as a result of this test?

How does Joseph respond when the brothers return to Egypt?

How does Judah respond to Joseph?

After Judah's speech, what does Joseph do?

Read 45:4-11. What do these verses reveal about Joseph's heart?

What does Joseph do to bless his family?

How does Jacob respond when he hears about Joseph from his sons?
The theme verse of camp is Genesis 50:20 - "You intended to harm me, but God intended it for good to accomplish what is now being done, the saving of many lives." After reading Joseph's story, what does this verse mean to you?

Prayer Prompts

Pray that these verses would affect our hearts and minds.

Praise God that he turns evil into good.

Pray that he would help us forgive others just as Joseph forgave his brothers.

Pray that God would help us be kind to others even though we are tired.
